## **MEMORANDUM**

Subject : Constitution of Selection Committee at DeGS for selection of VLEs under CSC 2.0 Scheme

Department of Electronics & Information Technology (DeitY), Government of India has recently formulated CSC 2.0 Scheme and issued Guidelines for implementation of this new Scheme in pursuance of the Government's commitment to set up one CSC at each of the 2.5 lakh Gram Panchayats to provide public services to citizens living in the rural areas. The new Scheme would also include strengthening and integrating the one lakh CSCs already set up and operational under the existing CSC Scheme.

- The new Scheme provides that the State/UT Administration would empower the DeGS for selection of VLEs through suitable mechanism. It is laid down in the Scheme that for the purpose of selection of VLEs in the region, the State/UTs may invite application through DeGS or SDA and select the VLEs through a panel chaired by DM/DC heading DeGS and other members like - representatives of NIC (District Informatics Officer-DIO), CSC-SPV or any other member.
- In pursuance of the above provision, the Secretary IT/Secretary (In-Charge of CSC Project) of all State Governments/UT Administration are requested to constitute a Selection Committee comprising of at least 4 (four) members – DeGS under District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/District Collector, DIO (NIC), a representative of local Panchayat Body or equivalent and a representative of CSC-SPV, for selection of VLEs for the uncovered Gram Panchayats. The District Magistrate/Deputy Commissioner/District Collector shall be the chairman of the Committee. The Committee may kindly be constituted by 15 December, 2015 and communicated to the District Magistrate/Deputy NCE SERV Commissioner/District Collector concerned immediately
