**Subject: Minutes of the Meeting of Screening Committee held on 16.04.2018 at 4.00 p.m. for consideration of applications for appointment on Compassionate Grounds in MeitY**

A meeting of Screening Committee constituted for considering the cases for Compassionate Appointment in the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology was held on 16.04.2018. The Committee comprised the following:

2. The points for consideration before the Committee were:


- I) Inclusion of 03 (Three) fresh applications of the following candidates in the pending list for Compassionate Appointment:
- Request of Smt. Meena Prasad, W/o Late Shri Kameshwar Prasad, Ex-SSA for appointment for herself on compassionate grounds in MeitY.
  - Request of Shri Gaurav S/o Late Shri Amar Singh, Ex-MTS for appointment for himself on compassionate grounds in MeitY.
  - Request of Smt Indira Pant W/o Late Shri Lalit Prasad Pant, Tradesman 'E' for appointment of her daughter ( Ms. Shobna) on compassionate grounds in MeitY.
- II) It has been noticed from the documents placed before the Committee that Smt. Meena Devi W/o Late Shri Dig Ram vide her application dated 17<sup>th</sup> May 2014 has requested for appointment of her son namely Shri Pradeep Kumar due to her physical inability and Smt. Malti Devi W/o Late Shri Jai Dev Rai , vide her application dated 18.01.2018 has also requested for appointment of her younger son Sh. Shashank Rai in place of her elder son Shri Nishant Rai as he has got married and living separately. The committee agreed to the replacement of Smt. Meena Devi and Shri Nishant Rai.
- III) To adjudge the suitability of the candidates for appointment on Compassionate grounds based on the criteria followed by Department of Posts mentioned in their letter No. 37-36/2004-SPB-1/C dated 20.01.2010 and adopted by this Ministry with the approval of Competent Authority as well as instructions issued by DOPT in the matter, the details of pending applications for compassionate appointment are as follows:

  - Sh. Sachin Kumar, S/o Late Shri Phool Chand, Ex-UDC, Mother: Smt. Kaushalya Devi
  - Sh. Sanjeev Kumar, S/o Late Shri Sohan Lal, Ex-Peon, Mother: Smt. Sumitra Devi
  - Sh. Mahesh Kumar, S/o Late Shri Raj Kumar, Lab Assistant 'B', Mother : Smt. Santosh Devi
  - Sh. Pradeep Kumar, S/ o Late Shri R.K. Antil, Ex-UDC , Mother : Smt. Santosh
  - Sh. Shashank Rai S/o Late Shri Jai Dev Rai. Ex-LDC, Mother : Smt. Malti Devi



3. For adjudging the suitability of candidates, Committee deliberated on the above issues/points in the light of criteria fixed by MeitY, Govt's instructions on subject matter and information provided by applicants against the inputs sought by Personnel Div, MeitY. Summary sheet of the points earned by each applicant (old and new) based on the criteria adopted by the Ministry was also taken into account (Annexure). After detailed discussions, the Committee recommended as under:


- (i) Inclusion of three fresh applicants (as indicated at para 2 (I) above) in the pending list for consideration along with the six other pending cases as indicated at para 2(III) above.
- (ii) While considering the application of Smt. Indira Pant W/o Late Shri Lalit Pant, -Ex-Trademan 'E' for appointment of her daughter ( Ms.Shobna) on compassionate grounds, Committee took note of the financial position of the applicant as the monthly income of her family comes around Rs. 95,000/- approx. which includes income of Smt. Indira Pant W/o Late Shri Lalit Pant, who herself is a Government servant and working in NDMC and earning Rs. 55,000/- per months. Therefore, Committee was of the opinion that her case does not merit consideration.
- (iii) **Smt. Meena Prasad w/o Late Shri Kameshwar Prasad, Ex-SSA**, to be offered appointment on Compassionate grounds keeping in view mainly the following besides other aspects:
  - (a) Smt. Meena Prasad earned 59 merit points which is the highest amongst all the nine listed candidates.
  - (b) Smt. Meena Prasad has two dependents children [ son (20 years) and one minor daughter (14 years)] at present.
  - (c) Keeping in view the educational qualification of Smt. Meena Prasad (12<sup>th</sup> Pass) the Committee also recommended that efforts may be made to offer her appointment at appropriate level in Group "C" grade as per the Scheme of Compassionate Appointment.
- (iv) As regards other cases of: (1) Sh. Pradeep Kumar S/o late Shri Dig Ram, Ex-Chair Recainer- Cum- Polishman (2) **Sh. Sachin Kumar, S/o Late Shri Phool Chand, ex-UDC**, (3) **Sh. Sanjeev Kumar S/o Late Shri Sohan Lal, ex-Peon**, (4) **Shri Mahesh Kumar, S/o Shri Raj Kumar, Ex- Lab Assistant** (5)**Shri Pradeep Kumar S/o Late Shri R.K.Antil, ex-SSA**, (6) **Shri Nishant Rai , S/o Shri Jai Dev , Ex-LDC** and (7) **Shri Gaurav S/o Shri Amar Singh, Ex-MTS** , the Committee took note of their particulars and the information in the relevant attributes meant for relative merit points and recommended to keep them in the pending list.

4. The above recommendations of the Committee is based on the statement containing personal particulars prepared by the Personal Division and presented before the Committee.
