Monthly Achievements for the month of June, 2024

The significant developments pertaining to Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology for the month of June, 2024 are as given below:

1. Electronics Manufacturing

(i) Development of Semiconductors and Display Manufacturing Ecosystem in India

Following, applications has been approved under the scheme:

- a) One application has been approved under the Assembly, Testing, Marking and Packaging (ATMP) scheme
- b) One application for providing fiscal support for setting up a Semiconductor Fab facility in India.
- c) Two applications for providing fiscal support for setting up an Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test (OSAT) facility in India

Further, Twelve (12) applications have been approved under the Design Linked Incentive Scheme.

Boston Consulting Group (BCG) has been engaged for providing consultancy services for Modernization of Semi-Conductor Laboratory, Mohali.

(ii) Scheme for Promotion of Manufacturing of Electronic Components and Semiconductors (SPECS)

- As on June, 2024, 49 applications have been approved with proposed investment of ₹ 14,121 crore and committed incentive of ₹ 1,978 crore
- Disbursement status: As on June 2024, ₹ 485 crore has been disbursed to (12) applicants.
- Acknowledgement letter to 03 applications were issued by PMA after recommendation of the Clarification Committee under SPECS.

(iii) Modified Special Incentives Package Scheme (M-SIPS)

- As on 30th June, 2024, 320 applications with proposed investment of ₹ 84,900 crore are under consideration. Out of these 320 applications, 318 applications with proposed investment of approximately ₹ 82,867 crores have been approved, 1 application with proposed investment of approximately ₹ 24 crores has been recommended by the Appraisal Committee for approval, 1 application with proposed investment of ₹ 2,009 crore is under appraisal.
- As on 30th June, 2024, incentives of ₹ 2,377.06 crores have been released to 141 applicants.

(iv) Electronics Manufacturing Clusters (EMC) 2.0 Scheme:

- EMC 2.0 Scheme was notified on 01.04.2020 to provide financial assistance for setting up of both EMC projects and Common Facility Centers (CFCs) across the country. The scheme was open for receipt of applications up to March, 2024 with disbursement period up to March, 2028.
- Under the scheme, 21 applications for setting up of EMC projects and 10 applications for setting up of Common Facility Centers (CFCs) admeasuring an area of 7,398 acres with proposed project cost of ₹ 10,150 crores including Central Financial assistance of ₹ 4,750 crores have been received.
- 6 applications with project cost of ₹ 2,323.81 crore including Central financial assistance of ₹ 1,111.37 crores have been accorded approval. Another 1 application with project cost of Rs. 569.66 crores including Central Financial assistance of Rs. 258.10 crores has been recommended for approval.
- An amount of ₹ 184.91 crore (including PMA charges) has been released towards execution of scheme & project therein.

2. Minimum Government, Maximum Governance

- (i). **Jeevan Pramaan**: A total of 3,36,158 Digital Life Certificates (DLCs) have been generated in the month of June 2024.
- (ii). **MyGov**: Till June 2024, MyGov has 1009 discussion themes and 1603 tasks. Around 4.78 crore people have registered on the Platform.
- (iii). **Open Government Data Platform (OGD) India**: Till June 2024, more than 6.25 lakh resources have been contributed under 13,097 catalogs and 3,200 Visualizations and 2,37,071 Datasets APIs have been created. 1,02,35,265 datasets have been downloaded.
