The Government of India has approved a scheme titled “Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA)” to usher in digital literacy in rural India by covering 6 crore rural households (one person per household).

As on 25th August 2022, a total of around 6.28 crore candidates have been enrolled and 5.37 crore have been trained, out of which 4.00 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme.
