

Additionally, I am interested in any reports or assessments conducted to evaluate the effectiveness of these efforts.	<p>To enhance digital adoption, the Government is focusing on providing digital literacy to citizens across the country, especially in rural areas. In line with this, the Pradhan Mantri Gramin Digital Saksharta Abhiyan (PMGDISHA) was approved in February 2017 to usher in digital literacy in rural India with a target to cover 6 crore rural households (one person per household) across the country.</p> <p>As on 31st March 2024, around 6.45 crore candidates have been trained, out of which 4.83 crore candidates have been certified under the PMGDISHA Scheme. The PMGDISHA Scheme has been officially concluded on 31.03.2024.</p> <p>The impact assessment study of the scheme was carried out by Indian Institute of Public Administration (IIPA), New Delhi in 2020. IIPA, after the comprehensive and methodological evaluation of scheme, concluded in the report that PMGDISHA as a digital literacy programme plays an indispensable part in not only bridging the digital gap in the country but also transforming it into a knowledge economy and society.</p>
